

Brief Run-through of 2023 Projects and Carry-Overs

- ➤ GIPC Publishes TSCA Data Collection Tool Template standardizes data collection for Toxic Substances Control Act PBT prohibitions.
- ➢ GIPC Publishes AS6496A Completes a 5-Year Review − Review led by TTI's Kevin Sink, Vice President of Total Quality with SAE's G-19 Committee...Article published in January's issue of Electronic Sourcing
- > GIPC Publishes Cyber Security Guidance Document Managing Cyber Security for International Operations
- ➤ GIPC Launches 2D Barcode Review After completing the 5-Year Review this labeling specification will be converted to an ECIA (EIA) standard <u>ECIA Publishes Labeling Standard on 2D Barcode (ecianow.org)</u>
- ➤ GIPC Publishes Date Code Restrictions Guidance Document Replaces 2002 NEDA version, offers updated recommendations to the authorized channel.
- ➤ EU REACH Restrictions on PFAS Will Have Major Impact ECIA's GIPC, in cooperation with other industry organizations urges manufacturers to get engaged.
- ➢ GIPC Explores ESG GIPC will concentrate its efforts on the "E" in ESG where many of these new priorities are being worked on within the Environmental SME (Subject Matter Expert) work group.
- ECIAs Workplace Disruption Group Meets Work group met from 2020 to 2022 and published 3 documents. Their meeting again in 2023 to revisit continued changes in the workplace.
