The 2017 Economic Census Is Coming Response Required by Law | Due Date: June 12, 2018



The U.S. Census Bureau measures the nation's population once every 10 years. It also measures U.S. businesses every 5 years with the Economic Census. Companies who receive the 2017 Economic Census are required by law to respond. The due date is June 12, 2018.
