

TPC Semiconductor Survey Report



The most recent TPC monthly survey polled ~9,900 respondents. It shows continued improvements in C1Q21 growth and seasonality expectations. While C2Q's outlook did moderate slightly, the seasonality outlook for C2Q continues to be much better than in the

previous 4 years. The survey showed a growth outlook for C1Q21 improving versus last month. In addition, it seems end customers have become more comfortable with higher inventory levels. <u>Click here</u> to review the survey report.


