Coronavirus Survey Report - Update #9 Now Available




As the Coronavirus / COVID-19 pandemic continues to impact electronics components supply chain participants, the most recent data from ECIA's survey of manufacturers and distributors yields a picture of modest overall improvement and stabilizing results. The results reflect the hopeful economic uncertainty that still exists as many states have pulled back

from reopening businesses in the face of renewed growth in COVID-19 cases. Other factors such as societal unrest and competing federal government stimulus plans continue to leave supply chain managers in a challenging position. There is no clear trend one way or the other in the overall economy and that is reflected in the electronics components industry.
