TTB assembled a panel of experts to explore a wide range of issues employers are facing as they respond to the COVID-19 pandemic. This thoughtful and in-depth discussion included data security and risk management issues related to working from home, such as employer rights for monitoring and controlling work environments when workers are remote; the challenges of joiners, movers, and leavers when IT support can't physically access the hardware; what to do about freelancers and contractors; ways to monitor employees without collecting their data and much more.

The most recent TPC monthly survey polled over 10,700 active industry professionals across the globe. The survey shows continued weakening in C3Q growth expectations and the initial C4Q outlook is weaker than last year. Availability of critical parts
